The technical bids of above mentioned bidders were evaluated by the Technical Evaluation Committee of ITU, in the light of Technical Evaluation Criteria and required technical specifications published in Tender Document. The Committee found the following bidders as technically responsive bidders in subject tender:

- ii) **M/s. Multilynx**

4. Financial bids of above mentioned technically responsive bidders were opened publically during Purchase Committee Meeting held on **01st July, 2020**. The detailed results with reference

to the financial proposal evaluation guidelines given in published tender document were also duly announced in the presence of all committee members and bidders.

5. **M/s. Multilyn** was, thus, turned out as financially lowest evaluated bidder. Therefore, the Purchase Committee of ITU proposed to award the contract to **M/s. Multilyn**, as per provision under Rule-55 of Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.
